Get Ready

Download the SmartLife app onto your smartphone. This app available for both iOS and Android Devices.



Connect your mobile to 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi network.

Enable the Location & Bluetooth on your mobile.

Register an Account on Smart Life App



STEP 1.

Select the country.

Enter Email address.



STEP 2.

Enter the verification code and create a password.

Plug in & Device Reset

This controller works with DC Supply do not connect the controller directly to the AC Supply.

Connect the controller in between the Power Supply and the strip Light.

For Single channel strip light, connect Power supply VCC to V+ of controller and GND to V- of controller



Connect Strip light Vcc to V+ of controller and GND to V- of controller

Plug in & Device Reset

For 2 channel strip light, connect VCC to V+, Cool White to CW and Warm White to WW of the controller output Terminal.

For RGB strip light, connect VCC to V+, Red to R, Green to G and Blue to B of the controller output Terminal.

After input and output connections, Power Off and power On the Power Supply slowly for 7 times until strip light turns in to nreathing mode.

If the Light not turn to breathing mode then, wait for 10 seconds after continuous On and Off for 7 times.

During the configuration process, the strip colour breath in White for 2-channel strip & Red colour for RGB Strip

Add Device

Ensure your phone's Bluetooth & Location are enabled.

Tap the icon "+" on the top right corner of the 'Smart Life' App, then select "Add Device", and the device will be automatically discovered and click 'Add' on beside the device.







Add Device

Follow the app instructions to connect the device to your Wi-Fi Network.

Once connected, the app will prompt the connection, and clock 'Done'.

Now control the strip light though the App.





Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can I share the device with Family and Friends? Yes, you can share your devices with family and Friends In the App, select the profile option and click on the "Home Management" option, and you will be able to give or revoke sharing permissions. To share, the other user should already have downloaded the app and registered account.

2. What's the Wireless Range?

The range of your home Wi-Fi is heavily depends on your home router and the room's conditions. Check your router specifications for exact range data.

3. How many devices can I control?

The App can control an unlimited number of devices in unlimited amount of locations Your router may have a limit on how many devices can be connected to one router.

Frequently Asked Questions

4. My device can't be connected to network with App. Make sure the device is under the configuration status. Make sure the Wi-Fi with the internet is available and not too far away from the Router. Make sure you entered the correct Wi-Fi Password during the device setup process.

5. The devices appears "Offline" in App.
Make sure the device is Powered On.
Make sure the network is stable and the Wi-Fi

name and password not modified. If Wi-Fi name or password changed then, add the device again. If the network is normal, but it's still Offline. Then, check if there are too many devices

Then, check if there are too many devices connected to Wi-Fi Router.
Check your Wi-Fi router specifications for the maximum allowable connections to the Router.
You can restart the device and check the status.
